Guidelines for E-Poster Competition

1. ABSTRACT:

- a) Format of Abstract:
- **Title:** It should be self-explanatory regarding the content of the presentation.
- Credits: Name(s) of presenter(s) and the institution should be mentioned clearly.
- Implication statement: Briefly mention the clinical relevance of the poster being presented
- Main body:

For study- Background, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions and up to 5 references

For case report- Introduction, Case, Discussion, Conclusions and up to 5 references

- b) The word limit of the abstract is limited to 300 words.
- c) The abstract should be submitted by email to <u>airwaycongress2024@gmail.com</u>, airway.amf@gmail.com
- d) Last date for submission of abstract: 15th August 2024, 23.59hrs.


2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION:

Registration for the **CME** is a must for participation in the e-poster competition.

3. E-POSTER FORMAT:

a) Creating your e-poster

These instructions are written for PowerPoint, but are applicable to *any* other software you may wish to use. Use PowerPoint 2007 or newer, and set the dimensions of your poster to: **140 cm (55 in) width** x **73 cm (28.5 in) height**, in **landscape orientation**.



b) Number of slides: ONLY One (1).

- c) Make sure your text and background have a **large contrast** (dark lettering on a light background or the reverse).
- d) It's advised that for electronic posters to be read on-screen, a minimum 24-28 point size (or bigger) for body text fonts is used, to ensure optimal legibility from the usual distance of 3-5 ft. A little larger text (e.g., 32 point size) will provide even more comfortable reading.
- e) Recommended font types- Calibri, Arial, Tahoma, Times New Roman.
- f) Posters should include a title, name and affiliation of the presenter/ presenters. Presenting author should be highlighted.
- g) Use bulleted lists where possible instead of paragraphs.
- h) For embedded images .jpeg or .png file formats in a resolution of 72 or 96 dpi are preferred.
- i) Do not use animated effects, "animations" and videos.
- j) Before submitting, save your poster as a PDF file. All recent versions of PowerPoint and most other software applications allow you to save your poster as a PDF file from the "File > Save as" menu or through the "File > Print > as .PDF" option. Submit as a PDF file only.

4. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRESENTATION:

- a) Each participant will be allotted a total of 4 minutes for the presentation and discussion. The presentation will be blanked out automatically at the end of four minutes. The more time one takes for presentation, the less will be available for discussion!
- b) Your complete poster will be assessed by the judges in advance, so send your poster (PDF; SINGLE slide ≤40MB in size) by 30th August 2024, 23:59hrs by email to <u>airwaycongress2024@gmail.com</u>, <u>airway.amf@gmail.com</u>
- c) The poster, once submitted, can be modified up to **30**th **August 2024, 23:59hrs** on written request to Poster Coordination Committee at airway.amf@gmail.com. Subsequently the poster would not be accessible for any changes
- a) The participants should check their presentation with the audio-visual team before the start of the competition.
- b) Time lost in any technical glitch during the competition will then be the responsibility of the AV team and duly compensated.

5. PRIZES:

- All participants will get certificates of participation
- **Best three e-Posters** selected by the judges will be given certificate of appreciation to that effect along with attractive prizes.
- Decision of coordination committee and judges will be final.

All the rights regarding the presentation shall remain with the presenters and the organizers will take all possible care of the intellectual property rights of the participants.
