
## **E-Poster Competition**

## **GUIDELINES FOR E-POSTER COMPETITION**

- 1. The presenter must be registered for the CME.
- An abstract of ≤300 words should be submitted latest by 10<sup>th</sup> February 2020.
  - a. If it is a Study:
    - i. It should have an Implication Statement, i.e., the clinical relevance of the study – up to 50 words
    - ii. Main Body Having Background, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions and up to 3main References
  - b. If it is a Case Report/ Innovation:
    - i. It should have an Implication Statement, i.e., the clinical relevance of the Case Report/Innovation – up to 50 words
    - ii. Main Body Having Introduction, Case, Discussion, Conclusions and up to 5 main References
- 3. A panel of judges will judge e-posters. For this please prepare your poster as under:

## Creating your e-poster

These instructions are written for PowerPoint, but are applicable to any other software you may wish to use. Use PowerPoint 2007 or newer, and set the dimensions of your poster to: 140 cm (55 in) width x 73 cm (28.5 in) height, in landscape orientation.



- Number of pages (slides): ONLY One (1).
- Make sure your text and background have a large contrast (dark lettering on a light background or the reverse).

- It's advised that for electronic posters to be read on-screen, a minimum 24-28 point size (or bigger) for body text fonts is used, to ensure optimal legibility from the usual distance of 3-5 ft. A little larger text (e.g., 32 pt size) will provide even more comfortable reading.
- Recommended font types- Calibri, Arial, Tahoma, Times New Roman.
- Posters should include a title, name and affiliation of the presenter/ presenters.
   Presenting author should be highlighted.
- Use bulleted lists where possible instead of paragraphs.
- For embedded images .jpeg or .png file formats in a resolution of 72 or 96 dpi are preferred.
- Do not use animated effects, "animations" and videos.
- Before submitting, save your poster as a PDF file. All recent versions of PowerPoint and
  most other software applications allow you to save your poster as a PDF file from the
  "File > Save as" menu or through the "File > Print > as .PDF" option. Submit as a PDF
  file only.
- 4. Each participant will be allotted a TOTAL of **4 minutes** for the **PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION**. *The presentation will be blanked out automatically at the end of four minutes*. The more time one takes for presentation, the less will be available for discussion!
- 5. Your complete poster will be assessed by the judges in advance, so send your poster (PDF; SINGLE slide ≤40MB in size) by 14/02/2020; 23:59hrs by email to airway.amf@gmail.com
- 6. The poster, once submitted, can be modified up to 14/02/2020; 2359hrs on written request to Poster Coordination Committee at <a href="mailto:airway.amf@gmail.com">airway.amf@gmail.com</a>. Subsequently the poster would not be accessible for any changes.

Participants will get **Certificates of participation**; In addition, **Best three e-Posters** will be given Certificate to that effect along with a Cash Prize of Rs. 3,000/- each.
